

Recognized Security Practices:

Recognized Security Practices (RSPs) are standards, guidelines, best practices, methodologies, procedures, and processes developed under The National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework, Section 405(d) of the Cybersecurity Act of 2015, and Other programs that address cybersecurity that are explicitly recognized by statute or regulation.

OCR suggests providing evidence, such as:

- Policies and procedures regarding the implementation and use of RSPs
- Project plans and meeting minutes of RSP implementation
- Diagrams and narrative detail of RSP implementation and use
- Training materials regarding RSP implementation and use
- Application screenshots and reports showing RSP implementation and use
- Vendor contracts and statements of work regarding RSP implementation
- OCR also requires dates that support the implementation and use of RSPs for the previous 12 months
